Thanksgiving Break – No School: Foothills will be closed the week of November 20-24 for Thanksgiving Break.

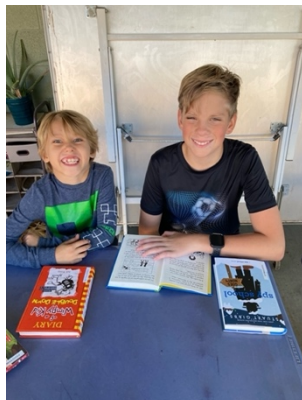
